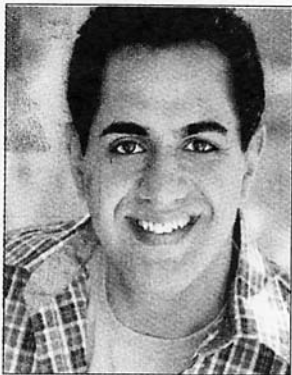


Dancing his way to glory
